2002 Riesling Grand Cru Kitterlé, Domaine Schlumberger.

I do not have a long track record of this producer but the recent vintages have made a very good impression on me. They are steely and elegant wines in the dryer style.

This Grand Cru Kitterlé shows a light golden colour and offers a fairly developed nose of pears, apples, minerals and quite a spicy, peppery touch. The palate is structured and a little bit on the earthy side, with plenty of mineral character, green fruit and a fresh, crisp acidity, nice and steely with a long spicy aftertaste.
